Each scholarship will be awarded to a student who will be graduating from a York County high school in this current school year (2024/25), is a credit union member of York Educational FCU as of date of application and plans to attend an institution of higher learning (accredited two or four year degree program) in the fall of 2024.

Applications will not be accepted for enrollment as part-time students, vocational, trade schools, or for adult education courses.

3. Provide Letter of Acceptance from the institution you plan to attend.
4. Declare your Career Goals.
5. Provide three (3) Letters of Reference; one of which must be from your High School Guidance Counselor.
6. Submit a printed essay written by you on a credit union related topic of your choice. It must be between 400 and 1,000 words in length. *Examples: personal experience, family experience, credit union philosophy, history, advantages etc.*)
7. Submit your completed application along with the above requested items by March 8, 2024, to York Educational FCU at 1601 S. Queen Street, York, PA 17403. All requested information must be included. Incomplete or late applications will be disqualified.
